SWISS CHANGES TERMINALS AT LONDON HEATHROW

SWISS operations at London Heathrow will switch to Terminal 1 as of June 11, joining seven Star Alliance partners already operating out of T1, with a further four set to make the move on June 16.

SWISS passengers will check-in at dedicated desks in the main check-in hall (Islands F & G). The SWISS ticket desk will be located just opposite the check-in facilities.

Significant investment on the part of BAA has seen Terminal 1 transformed into a more spacious facility with much better lighting than existed before. Its airside area features approximately 60 shops plus several bars and restaurants, which adds up to a far greater choice and more pleasant experience than was available in T2.

Airside, SWISS Business and Miles & More Senators will be invited to use the Star Alliance Business Lounge. Miles & More members with Frequent Traveller status will be able to use the newly refurbished bmi lounge.

SUMMER TIMETABLE: EXPANDED OFFER WITH NEW CODESHARE PARTNERS

- In collaboration with Star Alliance partner US Airways, SWISS now offers daily codeshare flights between Philadelphia and Zurich.
- The SWISS destination Singapore is now accessible non-stop from Zurich aboard up to two daily codeshare flights operated by Star Alliance partner Singapore Airlines. Codeshare agreements with Singapore Airlines are also in effect for connections to the daily SWISS flight Zurich-Bangkok-Zurich.
- SWISS now offers daily codeshare connections via Sao Paulo to Buenos Aires, Porto Alegre, Rio de Janeiro and Santiago de Chile. These flights within South America are operated by future Star Alliance partner TAM Linhas Aereas.

SWISS MOVES TO T1 AT BARCELONA ON 17 JUNE

Effective June 17, SWISS and all of its STAR Alliance partners will relocate to the new Terminal 1 (T1) at Barcelona Airport.

Check-in counters, ticket desks and gates for Star Alliance airlines will be on the south (or right-hand) side of the terminal. The SWISS ticket desk and check-in counters will be beside those of Lufthansa.

A new Star Alliance lounge will be ready in autumn. In the meantime, SWISS passengers with lounge access entitlement may use the AENA Airport Lounge.

Because rail service to T1 will not become operational until 2012, passengers arriving by public transport will need to use the shuttle bus service that runs every 7-8 minutes between the airport's two terminals.
